Aerial Lift Ticket Saskatchewan - Boom vehicles are often used by phone, cable and utilities firms as they have extended folded arms which are generally folded over the roofs of business vehicles. On the end of the extension of extendable arms usually sits a bucket-like apparatus. When a container truck has an extendable boom installed on the roof this is often referred to as an "aerial boom truck" or a "cherry picker". It can transport workers to the top of a telephone or electrical pole. Bucket boom vans have a hauling capacity of around 350 lbs to 1500 lbs or 158 kg to 680 kg and are capable of extending the bucket up to 34 feet or just over 10 meters into the air.

Heavy equipment boom vehicles or construction boom vehicles might have a hoist attached to the back. These cranes referred to as knuckle booms might be short and compact or be of the trolley boom type, where the crane is able to extend the span of the truck bed. Crane boom trucks possess a raising capacity between 10 to 50 tons or approximately 9 to 45 metric tons.

Concrete boom trucks are a different variation. The booms on these lift trucks have a pipeline with a nozzle at the extreme end and are utilized to pump concrete or other materials. The areas where these materials ought to be deposited is usually inaccessible to the truck or is located at a great height, for that reason, the boom of a bigger concrete boom vehicle may well be extended 230 feet or just about 71 meters. The vehicle then pumps the material through the boom completely depositing it into the space where it is required.

Fire engines are frequently equipped with a boom container able to lift firefighters up to the higher floors of structures. Furthermore, this boom will allow firefighters to direct the flow of water or to engage or rescue trapped victims. A lot of the older hook and ladder lift trucks have been displaced by contemporary boom vehicles.

There is in addition a miniature self-propelled boom vehicle, similar to a forklift that is existing on the market for huge warehouses or production facilities. These mini boom vehicles can elevate workers to upper storage areas or to the ceiling of the building. They are far safer and more steady than using an extension ladder for the equivalent function.
