Practical Programs

The practical training portion of the crane training school emphasizes hands-on learning. This section of the course focuses on the identification and terminology of crane components. The topics covered in the practical section comprises: Identify crane functions and components; Learn crane terminology; use remote control; identify rigging and wire ropes; pre-use inspection on crane; identify regulations and documents for wire rope and rigging; perform rigging techniques; utilize hand signals and radio; and carry out right lowering and lifting of loads.
